## **Topics Discussed & Motions Approved**

- January FFN will be delayed due to other activities that month already scheduled.
- **Thank you TARGET-** grant awarded for \$1,400 (green and pink cluster to see Alligator Under Bed at VanWeazel, intermediate to MOSI)
- Now have over 5,000 books in the library thanks to target grant, scholastic points and parent donations.
- Imagine the Places You'll Go- idea to take pictures of students in their spirit shirts in new cities, new locations etc and post on the board in the hallway.
- Window clings. \$590.00 for 1,000. A motion was made by Bailey Steigler, seconded by Melissa Hensley and passed unanimously. Members voted to sell clings for 1 for \$3 or 2 for \$5 (passed 14 vs 8)
- PTO donated notebooks to middle school and the students made thank you cards and were very appreciative.
- Outerwear Dress Code- Ms. Beauregard informed parents and staff that the intention of enforcing the policy was to make the school united not to impose hardship on families. Students can wear non-approved coats and jackets to school and to PE but will not be allowed to wear them in school.
