Topics Discussed & Motions Approved

- Bailey Stiegler: window clings vs car magnets for fundraiser. The group voted to purchase window clings instead of magnets, as long as the clings can go on the outside of the window. Also, the group decided that the clings should be sold to make the PTO some money instead of us giving them away to parents that had reached 20 volunteer hours. Cost \$280.00 for 1000 clings, a motion was made by Lisa Quiles, seconded by Bethany Pisz and passed unanimously.
- Ms. Helmuth: funding request for sight words curriculum for K-8 for \$100. (has 5 hours) a motion was made by Kristie Tonitis, seconded by Dawn Dunham and passed unanimously.

The PTO only stands to make around \$600 on this fundraiser, which does not give us much buying power at the end of the year. Additional fundraising ideas were brought up: entertainment books, publix gift cards, Raymond James stadium (possibility to split with LWR), note cards and live christmas wreaths.
